



CARPET STORAGE

We at Rugs International understand that at times, unforeseen delays in jobs and installation dates have caused our clients to store their carpets and rugs for extended periods of time.

To insure that your carpets and rugs will be in good condition for your installation, we have a few things to point out that will help you with storage.

If your installation is delayed and your carpet needs to be stored, our recommendation is to store all carpets and area rugs in a facility with racks that are off the floor on an even flat surface. The rolls must lay horizontally on an level and even racks or surfaces to prevent indentations in the materials that would result in permanent damage to the carpet or area rug. If they must be stored on the floor, make sure that the storage facility does not stack / pyramid the rolls of carpet on top of each other which is cause for additional roll crushing. Make sure that there is proper ventilation in the facility at all times

Rugs International is not responsible for materials being stored and will not accept any claims for damage. We are not responsible for any damage to Area Rugs or Wall to Wall Carpets including roll crushing, mildew, beetle infestation, fork lift damage or soil damage.

Most importantly, all shipments must be inspected within 48 hours of receiving the merchandise.
